For support or information, please call the **Government Helpline on 0800 779 997** (Monday to Friday 7am to 8pm).

If you've been affected by the fires, we may be able to help with:

- urgent or unexpected costs such as:
 - o petrol
 - o food
 - o furniture
- urgent living expenses such as:
 - o medical costs
 - house repairs or maintenance
 - replacing appliances
 - o bedding
 - o rent
 - o power bills
- lost wages if:
 - you have to stay home and look after family members
 - your workplace is closed.
- Costs of accommodation provided by friends or family in their home

Animal welfare

Call MPI on **0800 008 333 (option 4)** to log any animal welfare concerns. We're following up on animal welfare jobs logged across the valleys, and making good progress on making contact with owners. If you have phoned and have not had your issue resolved or been contacted, do call again.

You are able to collect your animals from the Richmond Showgrounds if you have been cleared to return home. If you would prefer to leave them at the showgrounds at this stage, in case there is the need to evacuate again, this is also fine.

Federated Farmers are distributing donated feed via the Feedline. Phone the Feedline on **0800 327 646 (option 2)** to request feed. Priority will be given to farms that have been affected by the fire and who rely on farm income for their living.
